Keynotes & Invited Speakers



Prof. Nkandu Phoebe Luo - from Lusaka, Zambia. She is the Minister of Higher Education, and a microbiologist who previously served as head of Pathology and Microbiology at the University Teaching Hospital in Lusaka. She has carried out extensive research into HIV/AIDS.



Prof. Robert Davison - from Hong Kong, is a Professor of Information Systems at the City University of Hong Kong. His research focuses on the use and misuse of information systems, especially with respect to problem solving. He has published over 90 articles in a variety of journals such as MIS Quarterly, the Information Systems Journal, Journal of the American Society for Information Science & Technology, IEEE Transactions on Engineering Management,. Robert chairs the IFIP WG 9.4 (Social Implications of Computing in Developing Countries) and is the Editor-in-Chief of the Information Systems Journal and the Electronic Journal of Information Systems in Developing Countries.



Prof. Stephen Simukanga – from Zambia, is the Director General of Higher Education Authority. He was Vice-Chancellor of the University of Zambia from July 2007 to June 2015. He is a Fellow of the Institute of Materials, Minerals and Mining and Chartered Engineer of the Engineering Council of the United Kingdom.



Professor Luke Evuta Mumba - from Lusaka, Zambia, is the Vice Chancellor of the University of Zambia (UNZA). a wealth of knowledge and experience gained over his illustrious academic and professional career spanning over 25 years. He comes from the New Partnership for Africa's Development (NEPAD) Planning and Coordinating Agency (NPCA) in South Africa. Between 2012 and 2016 he was a Programme Coordinator for the African Science Technology and Innovation Indicators Initiative of NEPAD.



Prof. Johann Kinghorn - from South Africa Johann Kinghorn studied at UNISA, Pretoria, Stellenbosch and Tübingen Universities in the fields of Economics, Classical Languages, and Hermeneutical Metaphysics (the latter for his doctorate). He received the German DAAD bursary (1974 to 1975) and the Von Humboldt Research Stipendium (1989 to 1990), the South African Human Research Council research award (1989), and the United States International Visitors Program (1986).



Prof. Lakshmi Narasimhan - from Australia, is presently a Senior Vice-President, Srikar & Associates International Inc., and a Full Professor of Computer Science at the University of Botswana.



Prof. Jeremy Sarkin - from South Africa, is a Professor of Law at the University of South Africa (UNISA) and Distinguished Visiting Professor of Law and member of CEDIS at Nova University Law School in Lisbon, Portugal.



Prof. Naison Ngoma - from Kitwe, Lusaka. He has thirty (30) years of experience in Management, both locally and internationally, at operational and strategic level in Government, Universities, Research Institutions and international organisations that include UN Agencies. Prof. Ngoma served in various portfolios as Acting Vice Chancellor of the Copperbelt University, Director, Consultant, Facilitator and head of different research and projects undertakings in education and specialized institutions.



Dr. Cornelius Niemand - from South Africa, has recently obtained a PhD in Information Studies from the University of Johannesburg. He is currently a lecturer in the Department of Information and Knowledge Management, School of Consumer Intelligence & Information Systems in the College of Business and Economics.
